

# Zeppelin Software Release History to Version 2.1.0

This list includes only those software versions issued in the general public domain and does not include interim versions that may have been used for internal development or limited beta testing.

## Version 1.0.3

Issued July 2007. Factory installed in Zeppelins incorporating Apple Class 1 authentication chip and with serial number beginning Z-0.

## Version 1.0.4

Issued February 2008. Factory installed in Zeppelins incorporating Apple Class 1 authentication chip and with serial number beginning Z-0.

- Feature set as v.1.0.3 with changes to accommodate power amplifier modification.

## Version 1.0.5

Issued February 2008. Factory installed in Zeppelins incorporating Apple Class 1 authentication chip and with serial number beginning Z-0.

- Feature set as v.1.0.3 and v.1.0.4 with changes to accommodate further power amplifier modification.

## Version 1.1.0

Issued August 2008. Factory installed in Zeppelins incorporating Apple Class 3 authentication chip and with serial number beginning Z-1.

- Added support for Class 3 in addition to Class 1 Apple authentication chips.
- Added ability to stream audio (eg from You Tube) through Z-1 type Zeppelins.
- Added code to power off iPod (to conserve battery life) if Zeppelin hardware detects a power fail.
- Added ability to limit maximum volume at installation time for corporate applications (not configurable by general user).
- Added code to allow video output from iPod touch and iPhone, which is enabled differently from earlier iPods.
- Fixed backlight dimming bug
- Fixed bug in operation of source change button on Zeppelin remote handset.

## Version 1.3.0

Issued October 2008. Uploaded to Bowers-Wilkins web sites as v.1.3 for consumer download and update.

- Added code to enable all the features of v.1.1.0 to be applied to Z-0 Zeppelins except that they require a remote key operation to allow streamed audio to be heard through Zeppelin.

- Added feature that iPod/iPhone can display Zeppelin software version when docked.
- Deleted "Display on TV?" message from iPod touch and iPhone, defaulting to always outputting to TV due to conflict that caused iPod touch 2nd generation and iPhone to cease audio output after 10 - 15 seconds.
- Fixed bug in v.1.1.0 that caused iPod 4th generation to ignore ◀◀ and ▶▶ commands.

### Version 1.4.0

Issued October 2008. Factory installed in batch of Zeppelins incorporating Apple Class 3 authentication chip and with serial number beginning Z-1.

- Functionally identical to v.1.3.0 but fixed EEPROM writing bug in original installation.
- Not suitable for hardware types other than Z-1.

### Version 2.0.0

Issued March 2009. Factory installed in type Z-2 (Works with iPhone) Zeppelins.

- Reinstated "Display on TV?" message on all iPod touch and iPhone models after conflict bug fixed.
- Added feature that iPod classic and 3rd and 4th generation nanos can display Zeppelin manufacturer (B+W as some iPods do not support the & symbol) and hardware version (either Z-0, Z-1, Z-2 or -0, -1, -2 according to iPod model) when docked.
- Fixed bug where iPod fails to authenticate when docked while in the process of rebooting. **As a result, an iPod 3rd Generation will take 20 seconds before audio can be heard through Zeppelin, so this update is not recommended for users of this iPod.**

### Version 2.1.0

Issued June 2009 following conflict with bug in newly issued Apple v.3.0 software for iPhone and iPod touch. Factory installed and uploaded to Bowers & Wilkins web sites for consumer download and update.

- Deleted "Display on TV?" message pop-up as this was found to be the cause of the conflict. Video once again forced to be directed to the TV (see also v.1.3.0 above).
